

foXet

You can process a file containing so called XML formatting objects by issuing the command:

```
texexec --pdf --use=foxet yourfile.fo  
texexec --pdf --use=foxet yourfile.xml  
texexec --pdf --use=foxet yourfile.xyz --xml
```

The shortcut `--foxet` can be used instead:

```
texexec --foxet --pdf yourfile.fox
```

If your file does not need graphics and/or cross references, you can do with one run and gain some speed by using the `--once` directive.
