This is a test of having the same work¹ mentioned twice in the same document.

If there is only one citation in the paper, then it thinks it can ignore the author altogether, except in the bibliography, so I had to include another $work^2$ which may help.

Perhaps the problem is being caused by putting in the footnote manually. But I don't want to have the author's name in the main body of the text.

If I don't put the citations in the footnote $style^3$, the author names are put in the sentences.

Here is the command I issued. No pdf template needed.

pandoc DoubleCommaBugv7.txt --toc --variable mainfont="DejaVu Serif" --csl=../../csl/modern-humanit
